# **Annual Dehydrated Garlic Exports**






- → Shrinking carry-over

- → Limited dehydration at current price








# Chinese Garlic - Supply & Demand







#### YEARLY FLAKES PRODUCTION, CARRYOVER & EXPORT (KMT)














### Chinese Garlic – Price Evolution



### Chinese Garlic – Futures Market



- AD Garlic as soft commodity on futures exchange (2021)
- Low entry for investment capital in the garlic industry
- Both commodity speculators & garlic processors
- Speculators' emotions vs real supply & demand
- Dec'22: China lifted COVID policies
- Jan/Feb: sudden high demands drained carry-overs
- Apr: speculators going short led to concentrated buying
- May: -10~15% reduced yields due to colder weather



## Chinese Garlic - Outlook 2023

- Why is the Chinese garlic market on fire?
  - Disruptive influence by the garlic futures market
  - Colder weather April end/early May
  - Speculation on expected yields
  - Increased demand in fresh & dehydrated garlic
- Impact for our industry at current price:
  - Declining fresh- & dehydrated carry-overs
  - Limited dehydration at current price levels
  - Emotional decisions by manufacturers & buyers
  - Speculation drives the business
  - Limited availability extra low bac & premium grades







## Indian Garlic - 2022 vs 2023

#### **2022 vs 2023 comparison:**

<u>2022</u> <u>2023</u>

• Acreage: 401K Ha 334K Ha (-17%)

• Yield: Reduced due to weather conditions


• Harvest: End February till May

• Dehy vol: Limited due to raw material pricing

• Exports: 21KMT (+13%) ?

#### 2023 forecast:

- → Garlic dehydration only after onion season
- → Limited dehydration due to fresh garlic prices






Dehy Vol: 10~15KMT


Carry-over: Limited to none
